According to food workers: Chicken cooked to 165F; Pork cooked to >150F

Educated on alternatives to using sternos for hot holding outside; sternos have a tendency to get extinguished when used outside

Educated on alternatives to gloves to avoid bare hand contact; suggested napkins; tongs; wax paper.
